2. 3. As regards foreign exchange required for above participation on the Federation is requested to approach authorized dealers for getting the foreign exchange in view of RBI circular No. 41 A.D (M.A Series) dated 25.1.97.

Such of the team – members who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (Which include departure abroad) in respect of the participation by the Departure / Office in which they are employed in teams of Department Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Est. (Pay-I) dated 30.1.1989. The federation should inform their employing Department / Office accordingly.
5. It is requested that High Commission / Embassy in Canada and organization of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
6. PA report on the visit of the along with its performance / achievement in the above event may please be sent to SAI within 7 days of the team to India along with some action photographs, if possible.
7. Before departure of the team, the federation may please have the report of Dope Test of members of the team from NADA.
