Minutes of the 19th Meeting of the Sub-Committee of TOP Scheme under NSDF held on 20th May, 2016 in the Conference Room of SAI.


DG, SAI & Chairman, TOPS Sub-Committee, NSDF chaired the meeting. Executive Director (TEAMS) and Project Officers attended the meeting. Director (Sports), MYA&S could not attend, as he is away on tour.

2. The gist of proposals considered and decisions taken is recorded below in a tabular statement format:-

S.No.	Discipline	Issue	Decision
1.	General	(i) Ms. Sapna's Training at Poland	(i) The issue of Ms. Sapna's (TOPS athlete) training at Poland be taken up with AFI and needful to be done immediately for sending her to Poland along with her coach for training with other athletes who are already undergoing training there.
		(ii) Attachment of Support staff with TOPS athletes in Coaching Camps	(ii) The Chairman, Sub-Committee reiterated the need to identify the support staff being engaged as the personal support staff of the athletes covered under TOPS immediately. The necessity of their inclusion in Coaching Camps must be deliberated upon by the concerned PO's before putting up the case for approval for inclusion in the Coaching Camps.
		(iii) Disbursement of Out of Pocket Allowance	(iii) Chairman, Sub-Committee directed that payment of Out of Pocket Allowance to all athletes for May, 2016 be completed at the earliest. Further, the Chairman directed that as per MYA&S norms 'Out of Pocket Allowance' is to be paid to TOPS athletes within their approved budget. However, in case of the athletes where the budget has exhausted, out of pocket allowance shall be paid over and above the approved budget until Rio-Olympics, 2016,
2.	Athletics	Training of Ms. Kavita Raut	Ms. Kavita Raut proposed to start coaching camp at Bangalore with immediate effect. Accordingly coaching camp for her has been approved till 31 st July, 2016 under ACTC and salary of her Physio will be covered under TOPS.



S.No.	Discipline	Issue	Decision
3.	Wrestling	Requirement project by ASI, Pune for procurement of branded personal kit items like Track Suits, T-Shirts, Shorts etc., for an amount of Rs.2,99,200/- in respect of Mr. Ravinder Khatri, 85 Kg, Greco Roman style	The proposal was approved for the procurement of personal kit items. The amount for extra diet money for fruits and juices is not approved, as he is training in the Coaching Camp at SAI Sonapat under ACTC and the same is covered under the supplement money.
4.	Para-Swimming	Proposal received from Mr. Suyash Narayan Jhadav for Training equipment gear, Competition equipment gear in Canada and Rio and details of training expenses in Bangalore	The Chairman approved an amount of Rs.5 lakhs for procurement of kit and gear for training in Bangalore. The Committee observed that the expenditure on balance proposals amounting to Rs.45 lakhs approximately is beyond the approved budget. Hence it was decided that the athlete should resubmit his remaining proposal within the approved budget i.e. Rs.30 lakhs limit.
